1. DURATION & FORCES

- 80-85 minutes straight through, no intermission.
- 4 Actors, harpsichord with string quartet. Optional additional oboe quartet (bassoon, oboe da caccia, oboe d'amore, oboe)

2. PRODUCTION PERSONNEL (TRAVELLING) - 5

• 4 actors and director Bill Barclay

3. PROPS/COSTUMES

- Venue provides:
 - 4 old unmatching wooden chairs
- Harpsichord, 4 or 8 music stands, stand lights, black chairs.

4. TECHNICAL

- Basic theatrical lighting is required.
- Musicians should have stand lights wherever theatrical lighting is used.
- Five countryman radio mic's are required four for the actors with one spare.

5. DRESSING ROOMS

- Space for 14 people.
- Private dressing room for Music Director

6. HOSPITALITY

- Bottled water, hot coffee and tea facilities at all venue services.
- Fruit and snacks.

7. SCHEDULE

• Actors arrive the day before the performance.
